ARES Training Level: Level 1 and Level 2 (Optional) and Level 3 (Strongly Recommended)

Description: This in person course provides training and resources for personnel who require advanced application of ICS. This course expands upon information covered in IS-100 through IS-300. The course prepares ARES participants to take on leadership positions such as EC, ADEC, DEC, ASEC, and SEC, and other designated positions in the ARES program.

Prerequisites: ICS-300 (G-300)

Registration Instructions: Search the Internet for SERT Trac and log into your account (Refer to Training Bulletin #3). Find the date and location of the course that you wish and signup. Make sure that you have met all the prerequisite requirements for the course. The system will send an email to your supervisor for approval. After entering the information on the course registration page, you will have to wait for your approval which could take a few days. Check back on the site often, but you should receive an email once you are approved to take the course. Once you successfully complete the course, you will be provided with your certificate.

Please remember to forward a copy of your certificate after successfully completing the course to your SERT Trac account and update your Taskbook.

Additional Related, Follow-up or Advanced Courses: Position-Specific Training: These courses are designed to provide State and local-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of Command and General Staff members. Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable participants to process and apply their new knowledge.
